

The second Transnational Project Meeting of the Erasmus+ project “I Can Manage My Money (ICMMM)” was successfully held in Kuşadası, Türkiye, on 5 September 2025, hosted by Kuşadası Sürdürülebilir Kalkınma Derneği.

This phase of the project focused on testing and adaptation of the project results, ensuring their relevance and usability for the target groups.

The meeting brought together all project partners to review the progress achieved since the Kick-Off Meeting and to ensure the effective implementation of the project activities. During the sessions, partners evaluated the development of the training materials and discussed the adaptation of the “You Can Manage Your Money” training programme.

A special focus of the meeting was the adaptation and testing of the “You Can Manage Your Money” training programme, ensuring that the materials are simple, practical, and accessible for disadvantaged adult learners.



The discussions also focused on how the materials can be effectively used with target groups such as low-skilled adults, migrants, and individuals with limited financial knowledge.

In addition, the partnership reviewed the distribution of tasks and confirmed the next steps of the project, including upcoming activities, dissemination efforts, and the organisation of future meetings.

The meeting ensured that the programme is aligned with real needs and is ready for implementation in different partner countries.

The meeting also provided an opportunity for partners to exchange experiences, share good practices, and strengthen collaboration in an intercultural environment.

This successful meeting in Türkiye marked an important step forward in achieving the project's goal of improving financial literacy among disadvantaged adult learners across Europe.
